MONDAY

Chess Club with Sam Graf & Luc Janssen – Grades 1-8 **FULL - NO AVAILABLE SPOTS**

The TCGIS Chess Club welcomes chess players of every ability who are interested in learning and playing chess. The club will offer multiple levels to meet the broad range of interests and experience of club members from an introduction to the game through tournament level coaching. Herr Janssen and Herr Graf will be coaching the team together this year. **Taught in English with some German.**

Lego Club with Chyna Davis – Grades 1-3

In Lego Club, we will build children's creativity and imagination while building great friendships through creativity. We are also incorporating stem projects through the course of lego club to challenge them to learn more and grow. **Taught in English.**

Improv with Laura Berger -- Grades 3-5

Learning improv games that encourage movement, creativity, and working together (for grades 3-5). **Taught in English.**

Improv with Laura Berger -- Grades K-2

Learning improv games that encourage movement, creativity, and working together (for grades K-2). **Taught in English.**

Girl Power is an inclusive martial arts based empowerment class for girls. GP is a space for girls to feel confident, strong and supported. Classes will include skills from Taekwondo, Kung Fu, gymnastics, yoga and self defense. Be fearless. Be you. These classes will be held outside whenever possible. **Taught in English.**

Middle school students will learn how to use Tinkercad to design simple 3D models and how to troubleshoot 3D printing. **Taught in English.**

Activities based around cultural and historical themes across world history. ie. building pyramids, writing haikus, braiding and beading activities-learn about how techniques were developed to make things we have today. **Taught in English.**

Advanced Girl Power is an inclusive class, focusing on middle school self defense essentials. AGP is open to girls and non-binary students. Together, we will build self confidence, self awareness, situational awareness, focus, flexibility and strength. Skills from Krav Maga (self defense), Taekwondo, Kung fu, gymnastics and yoga will be incorporated into the classes. These classes will be held outside whenever possible. **Taught in English.**

Make things with fabric, leather, cardboard, needle and thread and duct tape. **Taught in German.**
